3 on 3 Basketball

RULES:

- 1. 3 on 3 basketball is a half court game played by two teams of with a maximum of 4 people per roster. Teams must have three players to start a game.
- 2. All games are self-officiated.
- 3. Questions of judgement must be mediated by the two teams involved.
- 4. A **double forfeit** will be recorded for any games that cannot be completed due to disagreement between the teams
- 5. This is a double elimination tournament.
- Each match-up will play "best of three". First two games to 10; third (if necessary) game to 7. <u>First team to designated point totals wins</u> (no "win-by-2")
- 7. Game time is forfeit time.
- 8. 1 (30 second) time out per team per game.
- 9. Substitutions may be made after a basket or any other dead ball situation.
- 10. The possession changes after each basket (NOT MAKE IT TAKE IT).
- 11. The "Check Line" is located at the top of the three point arc.
- 12. The ball will be checked in after each basketball, foul, or any other dead ball at the Check Line.
- 13. The 3-Point shot is not in affect. 1 point will be awarded for all shots.
- 14. Defensive rebounds, **including air balls**, and steals must be cleared to the top of the circle behind the free throw line (6 feet behind free throw line) by dribbling or passing the ball.
- 15. Alternating possession on all jump ball situations will be in affect.
- 16. The offensive team must pass the ball once, after checking it, before a shot can be taken.
- 17. Any time the ball goes out of bounds or is knocked out of bounds, it must be checked in at the "Check Line" by the team entitled to the ball.
- 18. The 3 second lane violation is in affect for any offensive persons that have at least one shoe touching any part of the line marking the "Key".
- 19. All fouls (non-shooting and shooting) will result to a check in at the "Check Line" for the team that was fouled.
