- Proof of a current Springville City business license
- Sign shall be designed to the 2018 IBC and 2017 NEC and conform to <u>Title 11-6-310</u> Springville City Ordinance
- 2. Engineering required if the sign meets or exceeds any of the following criteria:
 - a. Projects more than 4 inches from wall or structure
 - b. Exceeds 4 lbs., per square foot, for sign
 - c. Stand-off dimension exceeds 2 inches from wall or structure
 - d. Exceeds 4 feet in height from grade for stand-alone sign
- 3. All electrical signs require UL listing as sign per NEC 600.3

Process after submission for a Building Permit:

- 1. Plans are reviewed on a first come first serve basis for complete submittals
- 2. Plan review can take several weeks depending on the current demand

Requirements when picking up Building Permit:

- 1. Payment of permit fees by CASH or CHECK only made payable to Springville City
- 2. Payment of completion and performance bonds
- 3. Contractor information if not previously known
