Street Sweeping Program



Springville City recognizes the importance of keeping all of the city streets clean for our citizens and for the environment. Currently, the City owns and operates one street vacuum sweeper.

Street sweeping is an integral part of our street and storm water maintenance program. The street sweeping season usually starts in March and ends in December. Weather and temperature impact start and end dates.

The primary objectives of the Street Sweeping program are to:

- Reduce health hazards by removing pollutants contained in or are part of the sweepings. Sweeping directly reduces PM 10 airborne dust pollution and the discharge of pollutants into the storm drainage system.
- 2. Reduce maintenance cost by keeping the storm drainage system clean.
- 3. Provide a clean appearance for residents and the visiting public.



Springville City is highly committed to keeping our streets as clean as possible. Citizens can help by keeping vehicles, trailers, etc., off of the street. We realize this is not always possible, but it would help in sweeping the entire street instead of going around vehicles that have been left on the street.

Please do not store landscaping materials in the street; this is also against city code 4-13-201.
