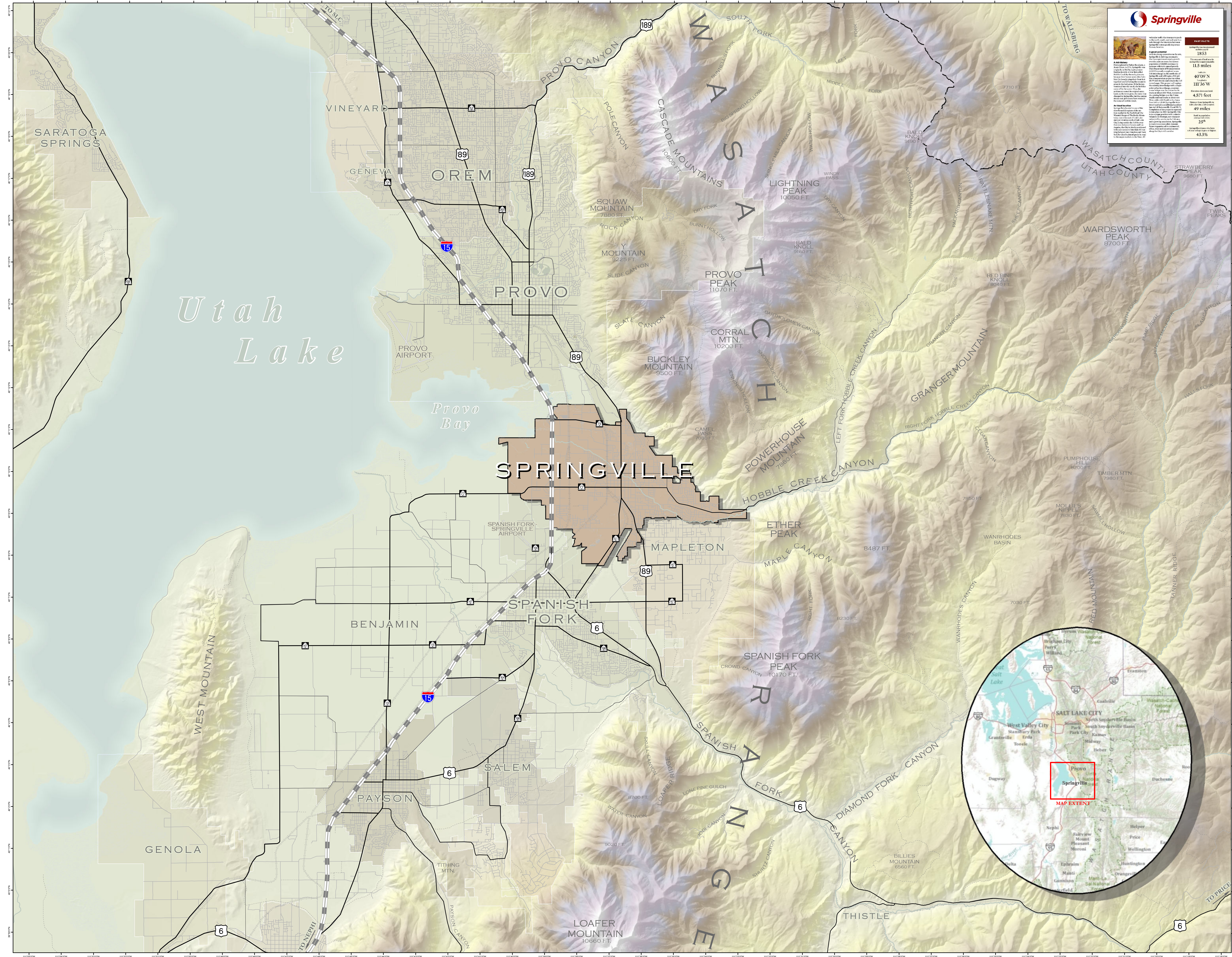


Springville
